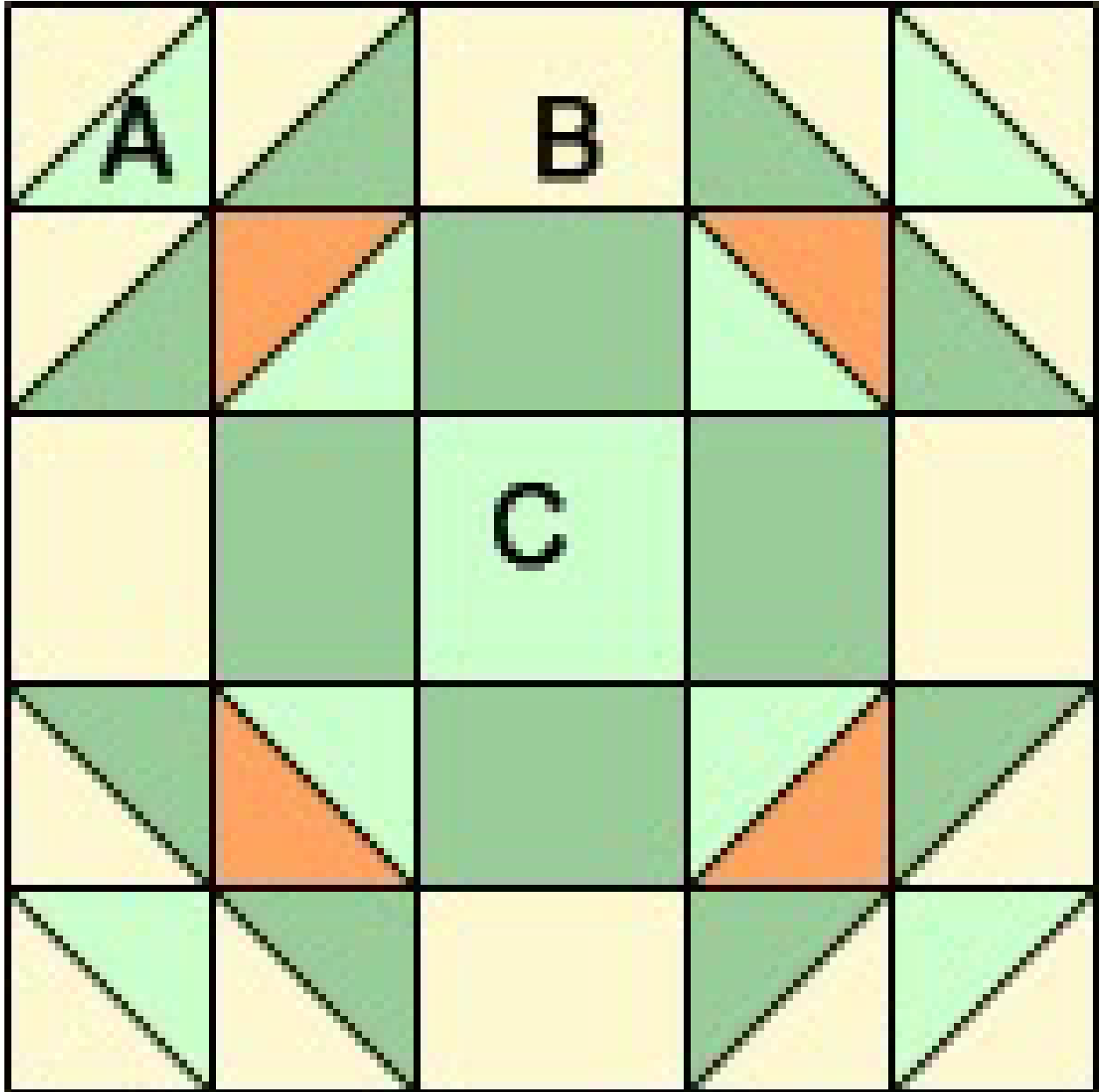


Christmas Star Oklahoma Block

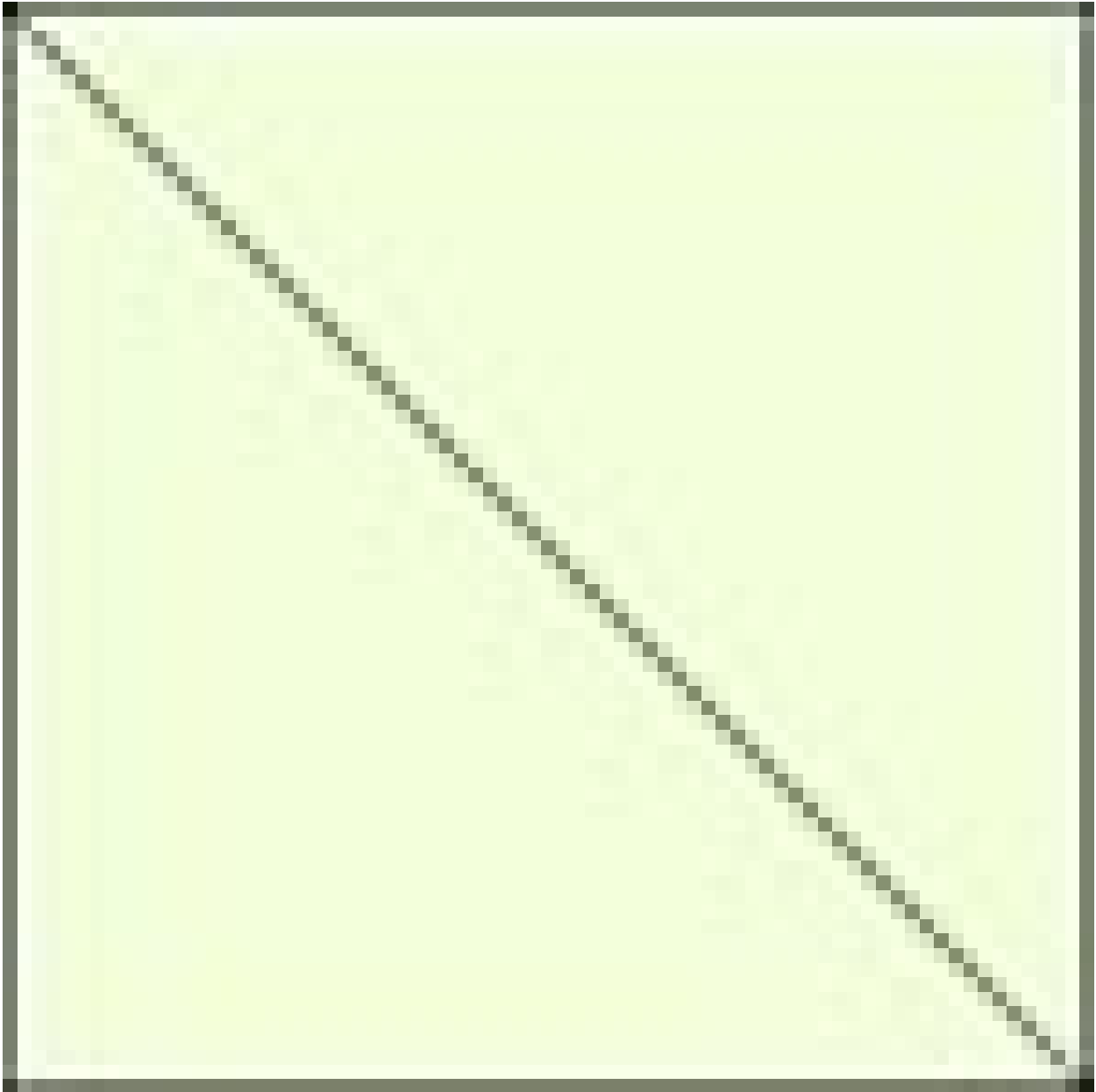
The pattern below wasn't created by us. However, with much perseverance, time, and effort, we've managed to provide you with the complete template for anyone wishing to create the best quilt block patterns.



Cutting an 8" Finished Block



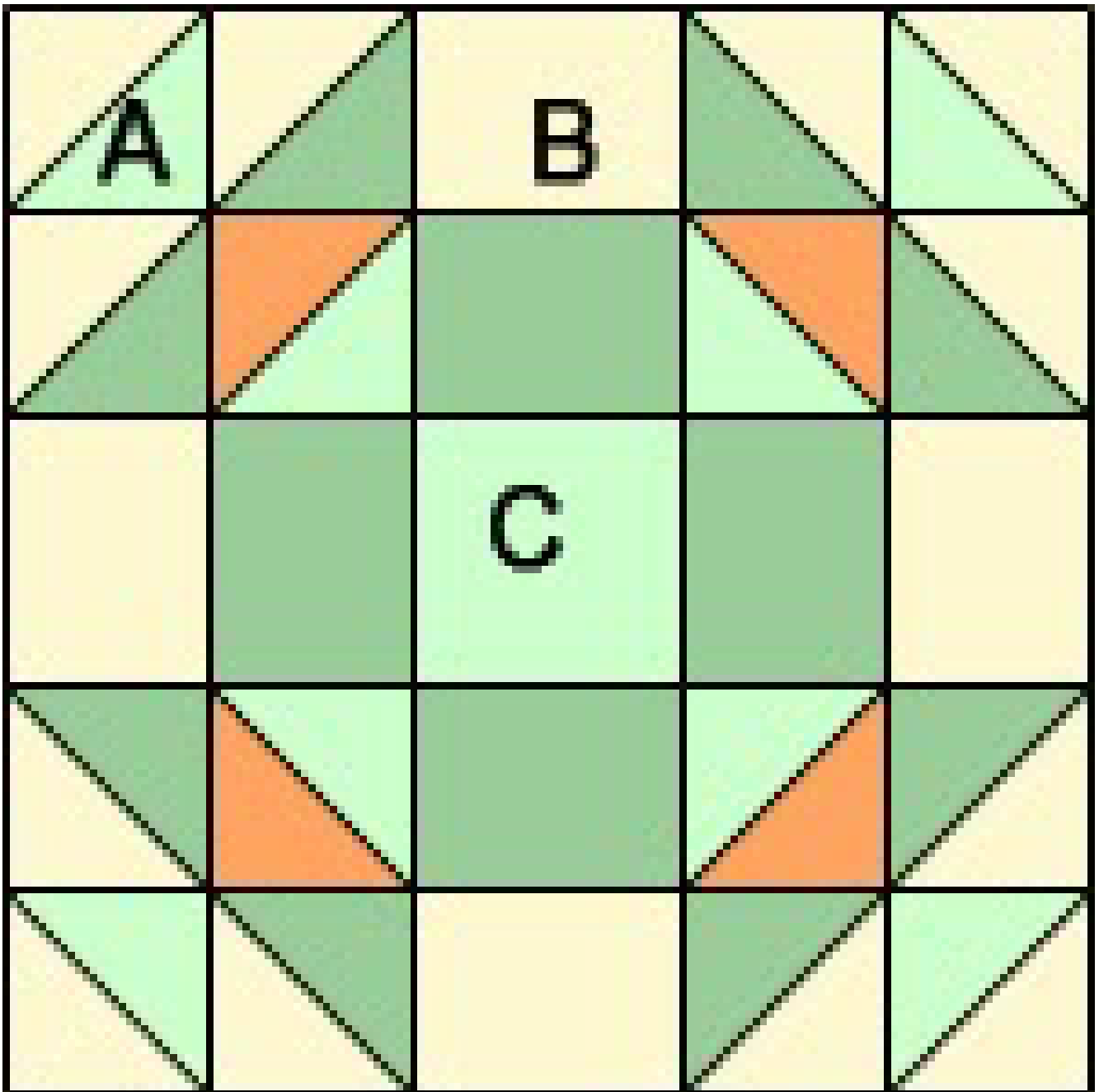
A - Cut 4 light green, 2 red, 4 dark green and 6 background squares 2-3/8". Cut each in half with a single diagonal cut.



You need 8 light green, 4 red, 8 dark green and 12 background triangles.


B - Cut 4 dark green and 4 background rectangles 2" x 2-1/2".

C - Cut 1 light green square 2-1/2".



Piece A triangles to make squares

 4 like this (light & background)

 4 like this (red and light)

 8 like this (dark & background)

 Make 4 four-patches for corners, carefully matching shading.



Join B pieces making 4 like this.



Make center strip. Piece 2 B units to either side of center square C.



Make 2 side units by adding four-patches on either side of a B unit.



Finish out the block by adding side strips to center strip.
