
Tumbling Charms QUILT

Instructions below are for the QUILT TOP ONLY!

Fabric needed for quilt top:


- 19 solid jelly roll (2.5") strips
- 80 charm squares (5")
- 7 jelly roll (2.5") strips for border (or create your own)

Use 1/4" seams throughout (and press open seams as you sew):

1) Cut 10 jelly roll strips into 5" pieces (you'll get 8 per strip) – total of 80 Sew these pieces to the 80 charm squares.



- 2) Cut 7(or 6) jelly roll strips into 7" pieces (you'll get either 5 or 6 per strip, depending on length of strip) you need a total of 35 (7"x2.5"). Set aside.
- 3) Cut 1" off of 2 jelly roll strips (the LONG way) so you'll have a full strip that is now 1.5" wide, instead of 2.5". Cut these strips into 7" pieces (you'll get either 5 or 6 per strip) you need a total of 10 (7"x1.5"). Set aside.
- 4) **LEAVE 10 charm square/strip sets (sewn in step #1) by themselves (set aside).**
- 5) With the remaining 70 charm square/strip sets Sew 2 charm square sets together w/the charm squares facing opposite directions, **EXACTLY** as shown in the picture below.




6) You will need to sew a total of *5 rows EACH* – of ROW A & ROW B.

See pictures below for a visual aid/placement. Be sure the charm squares are facing the correct way!!

(ch.sq.=charm square set from step #4; dbl.ch.sq.=double charm square set from step #5)

Sew 5 of ROW A: **single** ch. sq. set -7"x2.5" strip - double ch.sq. set -7"x2.5" strip - dbl. ch.sq. set -7"x2.5" strip - dbl. ch.sq. set -7"x2.5" strip - **single** ch.sq. set

Sew 5 of ROW B: **7"x1.5**" strip – dbl.ch.sq. set – 7"x2.5" strip – dbl.ch.sq.set – 7"x2.5" strip – dbl.ch.sq. set – **7"x1.5**" strip – dbl.ch.sq. set – **7"x1.5**" strip



- 7) Sew the rows together, alternating ROW A and ROW B.
- 8) For border, sew jelly roll strips to top/bottom & sides. (You will need to sew 2 together first, so they are long enough for the quilt.) **Or create your own border!!*
- 9) Finish quilt as desired. (If you aren't sure how to finish a quilt, Google it!! There are many resources out there!!)

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
