
This elegant lace square features a classic openwork motif framed by structured borders, making it perfect for decorative throws, pillow covers, or table runners.

Step-by-Step Instructions

- 1. Start with a magic ring.
- 2. Round 1: ch 3 (counts as dc), 15 dc into ring. Slst to join. (16 sts)
- 3. Round 2: ch 4 (dc + ch 1), *dc, ch 1* in each stitch around. Join.
- 4. Round 3: ch 3, 2 dc in next space, ch 3, *3 dc in next space, ch 3*, repeat around.
- 5. Round 4-5: Continue building corners with dc clusters and chains to shape the square.
- 6. Round 6: Frame the motif with structured rows of dc and ch spaces.
- 7. Final Rounds: Add multiple rows of dc with ch-1 spaces to form the clean lacy border.
- 8. Fasten off and block the piece for shape and crisp definition.
