Crochet Peacock Pattern - Full Tutorial

This PDF includes a complete, beginner-friendly crochet tutorial for creating the majestic blue peacock, featuring the body, tail feathers, and detailed stitch diagrams. Make sure to use worsted weight yarn and a 3.5mm or 4mm hook.


The peacock is composed of two main parts:

- Body and Head (main structure and base support)
- Decorative Tail Feathers (worked separately and sewn on)


Start with the body and work your way up, then crochet the feathers and attach them to the back.

Step-by-Step Instructions

- 1. Begin with the body using a magic ring. Crochet 6 sc into the ring. Join with slst.
- 2. Work in rounds, increasing by 6 sc in each round to form a sphere shape for the head.
- 3. Once the head is formed (approx. 5 rounds), continue with dc stitches to form the neck and torso.
- 4. Stuff the body with fiberfill before closing the bottom with decreases.
- 5. For the beak: ch 4, sc in each stitch back, fasten off and sew to the face.
- 6. For the eyes: use small black safety eyes or embroider with black yarn.

7. To make the tail feathers, follow the diagram provided. Each 'eye' of the feather is worked in rounds using color changes.

- 8. Make 9 to 13 feather motifs. Block them if needed.
- 9. Assemble the feathers into a fan shape and sew them onto the back of the body.
- 10. Add details like the crest using embroidery thread or strands of yarn.
- 11. Weave in all loose ends and enjoy your beautiful crocheted peacock!
