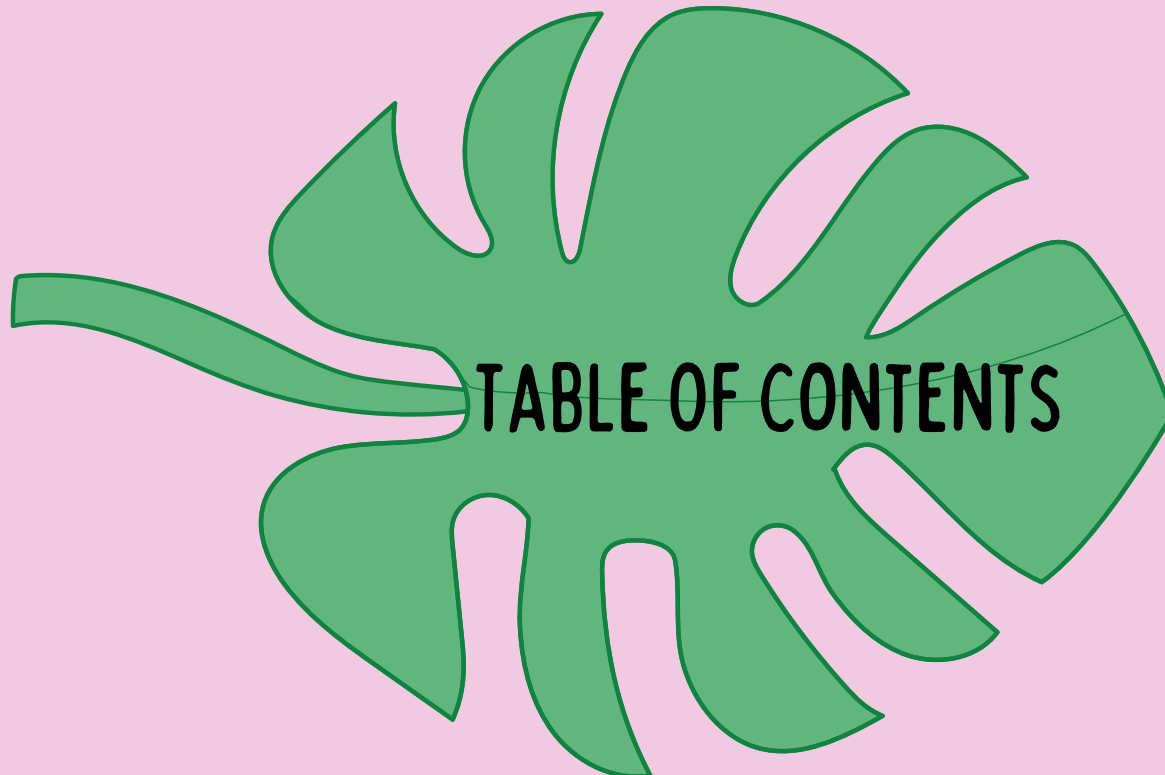


PINK ALIEN CROCHET PATTERN

BY CROCHETGROVE





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Skills Required

Magic circle, Single crochet, Invisible decrease, Fasten off, Chain, Increase, 3 single crochet increase, Slip stitch, Treble crochet bobble, Front loop only, Back loop only.
-If you are unfamiliar with any of these skills, there are tons of very helpful Youtube videos to help you!

Abbreviations

MR- magic ring
SC- single crochet
DEC- decrease
FO- fasten off
CH- chain
INC- increase
3SCINC- 3 sc increase (3sc in the same stitch)
SLST- slip stitch
TRBO- treble crochet bobble
FLO- front loop only
BLO- back loop only

IMPORTANT INFO

This pattern has a standing and sitting option for the alien. The head, ears, and arms are worked the same for both. The only difference is the legs and body.

3SCINC INSTRUCTIONS

- Work a single crochet.
- Work another single crochet stitch inserting your hook in same stitch.
- Work the third single crochet stitch inserting your hook in same stitch.

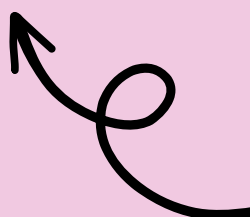
COLOR CHANGE INSTRUCTIONS

- Stop crocheting right before you pull through the last two loops on the crochet hook. Drop the old color of yarn.
- Put the new yarn color on the hook, and use the new color to pull through the last two loops on the hook.



TRBO INSTRUCTIONS

- To make a treble bobble stitch: Yarn over twice.
- Insert hook into stitch. Yarn over again and pull up a loop.
- Yarn over and pull through the first 2 loops on the hook.
- Yarn over and pull through the next 2 loops on hook.
- Repeat the steps above in the same stitch a total of 4 times. Do not pull through the remaining loops until there are 5 loops on the hook.
- Yarn over, pull through all loops on hook.

Felt

I use stiffened felt with heat and bond on the back and cut the whites the eyes 1.38in x 1.53in. The black of the eye is 1in x 1.11in.

For the nose I use lilac felt with heat and bond on the back and cut it at the size 1.1in x 0.78in. You can adjust the sizes if needed.

Other Supplies

4mm Crochet Hook, Stitch Markers, Yarn Needle, Stuffing, Scissors.

Right Inner Ear

R1 In Cottoncandy ch9, turn your work and place 8sc down the chain. Then working in the back side of the chains place 8sc for a total of 16sc in round 1.

R2 inc, 6sc, (inc)x2, 6sc, inc (20)

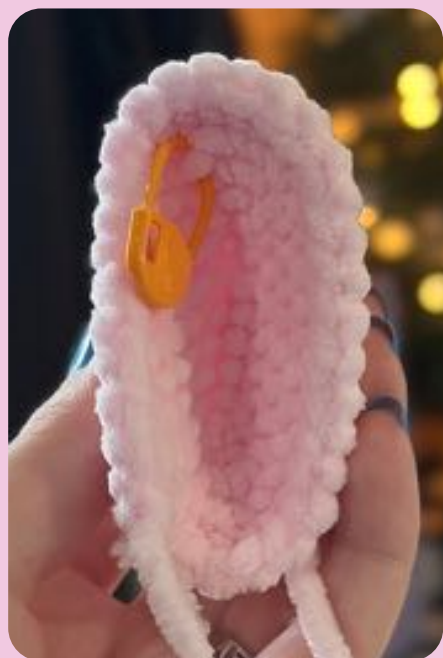
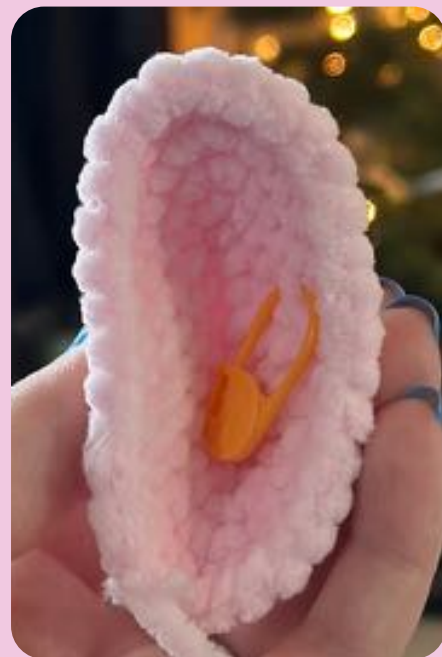
R3 (inc)x2, 7sc, (inc)x3, 7sc, inc (26)

In the next round place a stitch marker on the front loop that you will leave behind on the 12th sc.

R4 (inc)x2, 7sc, BLOsc, 3sc, (inc)x3, 9sc, inc (32)

R5 sc around (32)

FO. Leave a a short tail.



Left Inner Ear

R1 In Cottoncandy ch9, turn your work and place 8sc down the chain. Then working in the back side of the chains place 8sc for a total of 16sc in round 1.

R2 inc, 6sc, (inc)x2, 6sc, inc (20)

R3 (inc)x2, 7sc, (inc)x3, 7sc, inc (26)

In the next round place a stitch marker on the front loop that you will leave behind on the 22nd sc.

R4 (inc)x2, 11sc, (inc)x3, BLOsc, 8sc, inc (32)

R5 sc around (32)

FO. Leave a a short tail.

Outer Ear x2

R1 In Bubblegum ch9, turn your work and place 8sc down the chain. Then working in the back side of the chains place 8sc for a total of 16sc in round 1.

R2 inc, 6sc, (inc)x2, 6sc, inc (20)

R3 (inc)x2, 7sc, (inc)x3, 7sc, inc (26)

R4 (inc)x2, 11sc, (inc)x3, 9sc, inc (32)

R5-6 sc around (2 rounds) (32)

With your yarn still connected place the inner ear inside of the outer one and sc through both pieces. When you reach your stitch marker marking the front loop crochet through the outer ear and into the front loop to create an indent. Leave a tail for sewing repeat for the second ear.



Arms x2

The following instructions in **bold** are in lilac, instructions not bolded are bubblegum.

R1 MR 6sc (6)

R2 (inc)x6 (12)

R3 3sc, **3scinc**, sc, **3scinc**, sc, **3scinc**, 4sc (18)

Cut lilac off now.

R4 sc around (18)

R5 3sc, (dec)x6, 3sc (12)

R6 2sc, (dec)x4, 2sc (8)

Stuff only the paw and leave the arm unstuffed.

R7-12 sc around (6 rounds) (8)

Fold the arm in half and 4sc across.

FO. Leave a short tail if you will be crocheting the arms on.

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Legs Sitting x2

The following instructions in **bold** are lilac, instructions not bolded are bubblegum.

R1 MR 6sc (6)

R2 (inc)x6 (12)

R3 (sc,inc)x6 (18)

R4 4sc, **3scinc**, 2sc, **3scinc**, 2sc, **3scinc**, 7sc (24)

Cut lilac off now.

R5 sc around (24)

R6 6sc, (dec)x6, 6sc (18)

R7 3sc, (dec)x6, 3sc (12)

R8-9 sc around (2 rounds) (12)

FO. Leave a tail for sewing. Stuff.

Sitting Body and Head

Instructions in **bold** are cottoncandy, instructions not bolded are bubblegum.

R1 MR 8sc (8)

R2 (inc)x8 (16)

R3 (sc,inc)x8 (24)

R4 (3sc,inc)x6 (30)

R5 (4sc,inc)x6 (36)

R6 2sc, TRBO, 12sc, **11sc**, 10sc (36)

R7 15sc, **11sc**, 10sc (36)

R8-9 15sc, **12sc**, 9sc (2 rounds) (36)

R10 (4sc,dec)x2, 4sc, **dec**, **4sc**, **dec**, **3sc**, sc, dec, 4sc, dec (30)

R11 14sc, **9sc**, 7sc (30)

Instructions underlined use white.

R12 14sc, **4sc**, sc, **4sc**, 7sc (30)

R13 (3sc,dec)x3, **2sc**, sc, dec, sc, **2sc**, dec, 3sc, dec (24)

Begin stuffing.

R14 12sc, **sc**, 2sc, **sc**, 2sc, **sc**, 5sc (24)

R15 12sc, 2sc, **3sc**, 2sc, 5sc (24)

Cut off white.

R16 (sc,dec)x4, (**sc,dec**)x2, **sc**, dec, sc, dec (16)

We will be crocheting on the arms in the next round. Instructions underlined are when to crochet through the arm and body.

R17 4sc, 4sc, **5sc**, 3sc (16)

R18 sc, 7sc, **6sc**, 2sc (16)

R19 (inc)x7, (**inc**)x8, inc (32)

Stuff the neck.

R20 (2sc,inc)x4, 2sc, **inc**, (**2sc**, **inc**)x5, 2sc (42)

R21 18sc, **22sc**, 2sc (42)

Cut off the cottoncandy now.

R22-27 sc around (6 rounds) (42)

R28 (5sc,dec)x6 (36)

R29 (4sc,dec)x6 (30)

R30 (3sc,dec)x6 (24)

Begin stuffing the head.

R31 (2sc,dec)x6 (18)

R32 (sc,dec)x6 (12)

R33 (dec)x6 (6)

Finish Stuffing

FO. Cut yarn, leaving a few inches.

Use a yarn needle to thread through the back

loops of the remaining 6 stitches. Pull tight to close, weave in the end.



Legs Standing x2

The following instructions in **bold** are lilac, instructions not bolded are bubblegum.

R1 MR 6sc (6)

R2 (inc)x6 (12)

R3 (sc,inc)x6 (18)

R4 4sc, **3scinc**, 2sc, **3scinc**, 2sc, **3scinc**, 7sc (24)

Cut lilac off now.

R5 sc around (24)

R6 6sc, (dec)x6, 6sc (18)

R7 3sc, (dec)x6, 3sc (12)

R8-9 sc around (2 rounds) (12)

FO the first leg. Mark the 10th stitch of the last round.

Make a second leg, crochet a extra 4sc after round 9 do not Fo.

TIP-

Work in the back loops of the 3scinc for a cleaner look!



Connecting Legs/ Standing Body/ Head

With your yarn still attached to your second leg, take the first leg and place a sc into that 10th stitch with the stitch marker in it. This will count as the first sc of **R1**

R1 sc around 12 in the first leg and 12 in the second (24)

R4 (3sc,inc)x6 (30)

R5 (4sc,inc)x6 (36)

Instructions in bold are cottoncandy, instructions not bolded are bubblegum.

R6 TRBO, 12sc, **11sc**, 12sc (36)

R7 13sc, **11sc**, 12sc (36)

R8-9 13sc, **12sc**, 11sc (2 rounds) (36)

R10 (4sc,dec)x2, sc, **3sc, dec, 4sc, dec, sc**, 3sc, dec, 4sc, dec (30)

R11 12sc, **9sc**, 9sc (30)

Instructions underlined use white.

R12 12sc, **4sc**, sc, **4sc**, 9sc (30)

R13 (3sc,dec)x2, 2sc, **sc, dec**, 3sc, **dec, sc**, 2sc, dec, 3sc, dec (24)

Begin stuffing.

R14 10sc, **sc**, 2sc, **sc**, 2sc, **sc**, 7sc (24)

R15 10sc, 2sc, **3sc**, 2sc, 7sc (24)

Cut off white now.

R16 (sc,dec)x3, **dec**, (**sc,dec**)x2, **sc**, (sc,dec)x2 (16)

We will be crocheting on the arms in the next round
Instructions underlined are when to crochet through the arm and body.

R17 3sc, 4sc, **6sc**, 3sc (16)

R18 sc, 6sc, **6sc**, 3sc (16)

R19 (inc)x6, (**inc**)x8, incx2 (32)

Stuff the neck.

R20 (2sc,inc)x4, (**2sc, inc**)x5, **sc**, sc, inc, 2sc (42)

R21 16sc, **21sc**, 5sc (42)

Cut off the cotton candy now.

R22-27 sc around (6 rounds) (42)

R28 (5sc,dec)x6 (36)

R29 (4sc,dec)x6 (30)

R30 (3sc,dec)x6 (24)

Begin stuffing the head.

R31 (2sc,dec)x6 (18)

R32 (sc,dec)x6 (12)

R33 (dec)x6 (6)

FO. Cut yarn, leaving a few inches.

Use a yarn needle to thread through the back loops of the remaining 6 stitches. Pull tight to close, weave in the end.



Antennas x2

The following instructions in **bold** are lilac, instructions not bolded are bubblegum. Stuff as you go.

R1 MR 7sc (7)

R2-5 sc around (4 rounds) (7)

R6-9 **sc around** (4 rounds) (7)

R10-29 sc around (20 rounds) (7)

FO. Leave a tail for sewing.



Assembly

Ears

Sew three stitches down the side of the ear, sew the base of the ear lined up with the last round of cotton candy, and secure half way up the ear down to the head.



Legs Sitting

Sew on between rounds 4-9 of the body, leaving about 5 stitches between them.



Antennas

Sew on 2 rounds away from the top center of the head. I also like to secure the bottom of the antenna to the base of the head.
