

Velvet and Cotton Petal Crochet Flower - Step-by-Step Tutorial

Materials Needed

- White velvet yarn (bulky) for base petals
- Cotton yarn (DK) in pink for overlay stitches
- 4.0 mm and 3.0 mm crochet hooks
- Scissors and yarn needle

Stitches Used

- ch: chain
- sl st: slip stitch
- sc: single crochet
- dc: double crochet
- tr: treble crochet
- fptr: front post treble crochet

Pattern Instructions

1. With velvet yarn, make a magic ring.
2. Round 1: Ch 3 (counts as dc), 15 dc into the ring. Sl st to join. (16 sts)
3. Round 2: Ch 5, skip 1 st, sl st in next - repeat around to form 8 loops.
4. Round 3: In each loop, work (sc, hdc, 6 dc, hdc, sc) to create petal.
5. Join pink cotton yarn at base between petals.
6. Ch 5, work fptr around center of each white petal, ch 3 - repeat around.
7. In each pink arch, work (2 sc, hdc, 6 dc, hdc, 2 sc).
8. Fasten off and weave in ends neatly.

Tips for Beginners

- Work slowly with velvet yarn to avoid splitting.
- Use contrasting yarns for better visual definition.
- Light blocking will help define each petal.

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- Ideal for embellishments, coasters or garlands.
